Case #1: You are the banker. Prevailing wind is East. You mahjong on the hand shown below. How many points do you have based on these tiles?



- Prevailing Wind—1 point
- Seat-Position Wind—1 point
- No Flower—1 point
- All Pungs—3 points

Case #2: You are sitting across from the banker and mahjong on the hand shown below. How many points do you have based on these tiles?



Short Sequence—1 point
Mixed Dragon—2 points
All Chees—1 point

Case #3: You are seated to the left of the banker and mahjong on the hand shown below.
How many points do you have based on these tiles?



Seat Position Flower—1 point
All One Suit—6 points

Case #4: You are the banker and mahjong on the hand shown below.
How many points do you have based on these tiles?



All Chees—1 point

Seat Position Flower—1 point

No Terminals/No Honors—1 point

Case #5: You are seated across from the banker and mahjong on the hand shown below. Prevailing wind is South. How many points do you have based on these tiles?
(Hint: That West wind tile represents a concealed kong of the West wind.)



Seat Position Wind—1 point
 Seat Position Flower—1 point
 Short Sequence—1 point
 Twins—1 point

Middle Tile (Middle Wait)—1 point
 Concealed Kong—1 point
 Hybrid—3 points
