Case #1: You are seated to the right of the banker and mahjong on the hand shown below. How many points do you have based on these tiles?



Green Dragon—1 point

Seat Position Flower—1 point

All Five Suits—3 points

Case #2: You are seated across from the banker and mahjong.
 How many points do you have based on the tiles below?



All Chees—1 point

Short Sequence—1 point

End Tile (Edge Wait)—1 point

Triple Mixed Chees—3 points

Case #3: You are seated to the left of the banker and mahjong on the hand below.
How many points do you have based on these tiles?



Seat Position Wind (North)—1 point
Green Dragon—1 point
All Pungs/Kongs—3 points

Case #4: You are the banker. Prevailing wind is East. You mahjong on the hand shown below. How many points do you have based on these tiles?



- Prevailing Wind—1 point
- Seat Position Wind—1 point
- Seat Position Flower—1 point
- End Tile (Edge Wait)—1 point
- Mixed Dragon—2 points

Case #5: You are seated to the right of the banker and mahjong on the hand shown below. How many points do you have based on these tiles?



Seat Position Flowers—2 points
