

# Case Studies

Case #1: You are the banker. Prevailing wind is South. You mahjong on the hand shown below. How many points do you have based on these tiles?



Single Wait for Eye—1 point

White Dragon—1 point

Seat Position Wind (East)—1 point

Seat Position Flower (1)—1 point

Case #2: You mahjong on the hand shown below by drawing the winning tile yourself.  
How many points do you have based in these tiles?



All One Suit—6 points

All pungs/kongs—3 points

Single Wait for Eye—1 point

No Flower—1 point

Self-Drawn Tile—1 point

Case #3: You are seated to the right of the banker and mahjong on the hand shown below. How many points do you have based on these tiles?



All Chee—1 point

Twins—1 point

End Tile (Edge Wait)—1 point

Terminals—3 points

Case #4: You are the banker and mahjong on the hand below by drawing the winning tile yourself. How many points do you have based on these tiles?



- All One Suit—6 points
- Self-Drawn Tile—1 point
- Middle Tile (Middle Wait)—1 point
- Twins x 3—3 points
- All Chees—1 point
- No Flower—1 point

Case #5: You are seated to the left of the banker and mahjong on the hand shown below. How many points do you have based on these tiles?



- Seat Position Wind (North)—1 point
- White Dragon—1 point
- Middle Tile (Middle Wait)—1 point
- Hybrid—3 points

Options for honors: All Honors, Hybrid, Terminals w/Honors, 13 Orphans, Big 7 Pairs

## Summary of 2-Point Strategies

Look for high-point combinations.

Get one point at a time/meld with intention.

Default hand = Two Suits + All Chees = 2 points

Discard single honor tiles (winds and dragons).

Beware of melding non-scoring pungs.
