Case #4: You are the banker and mahjong on the hand below by drawing the winning tile yourself. How many points do you have based on these tiles?



All One Suit—6 points

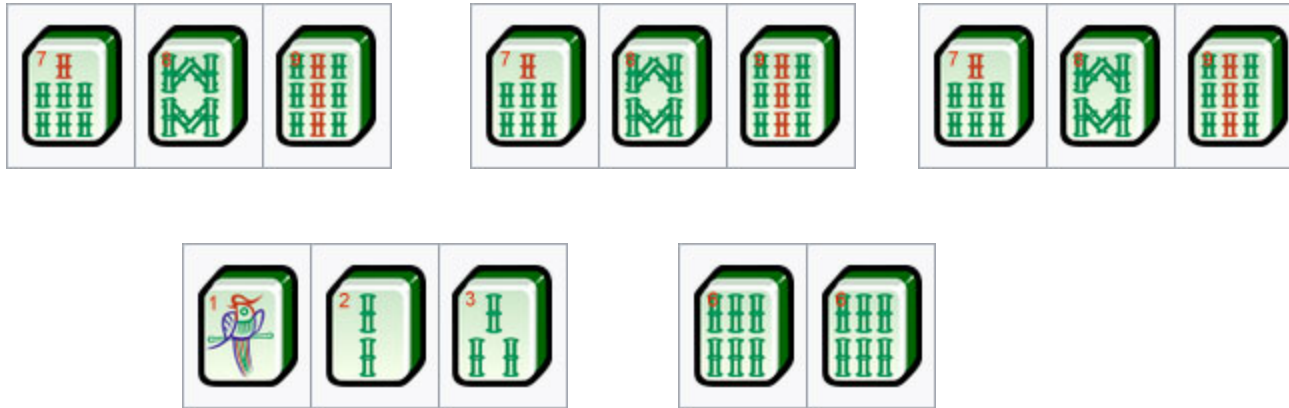
Self-Drawn Tile—1 point

Middle Tile (Middle Wait)—1 point

Twins x 3—3 points

All Chees—1 point

No Flower—1 point



3. **The Non-Identical Principle:** One triple cannot be used to score the same scoring rule twice.

- e.g. If you have a Chow of Circle 1,2,3, Chow of Circle 4,5,6 and two Chows of Circle 7,8,9, you can only receive the points for having a Pure Straight once. You cannot use the second Chow of Circle 7,8,9 to make a second Pure Straight with the same 1,2,3 and 4,5,6 Chows.

1 Point Rules

1. **Pure Double Chow** - Two identical Chows in the same suit.



24 Point Rules

(2.45 points)

59. **Pure Triple Chow** - Three identical Chows in the same suit.



Does not combine with:

1. Pure Double Chow

48 Point Rules

(4.9 points)

67. **Quadruple Chow** - Four identical Chows in the same suit.



Does not combine with:

1. Pure Double Chow
19. Tile Hog
59. Pure Triple Chow

How many points do you have based on these tiles?



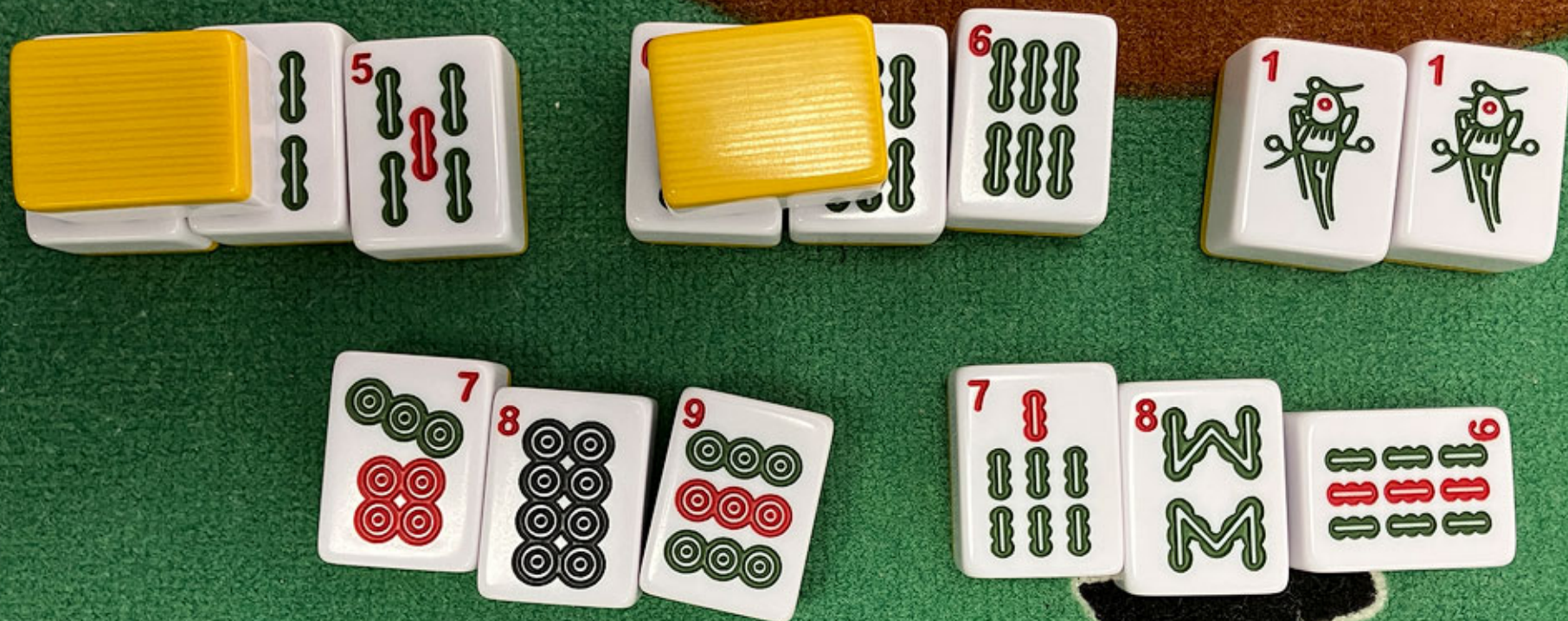
Two Suits—1 point

Seven Sisters—6 points

Seat Position Flower (3)—1 point

(With Seven Sisters, no points for Concealed Hand, All Five Suits, or Single Wait for Eye)

Case #2: You are the banker and mahjong on the hand shown below. The upside-down tiles are indicating concealed kongs. You also have no visible melded tiles when you mahjong. How many points based on these tiles and this scenario?



Concealed Kong x 2—2 points

Two Suits—1 point

Concealed Hand—1 point

No Flower—1 point

Case #3: You are the banker. Prevailing wind is South. You mahjong on the hand shown below. How many points do you have based on these tiles?



Seat Position Wind (East)—1 point

White Dragon—1 point

All Five Suits—3 points

Case #4: You are the banker and mahjong on the hand shown below.
How many points do you have based on these tiles?



Single Wait for Eye—1 point
Two Suits—1 point
Short Straight x 2—2 points
No Flower—1 point
All Chees—1 point
