Seat Position Flower—1 point
Single Wait for Eye—1 point
Short Straight—1 point
All One Suit—6 points

Case #3: You are seated to the left of the banker and mahjong on the hand shown below. How many points do you have based on these tiles? Winning tile was green dragon.



Seat Position Flower—1 point
Little Three Dragons—6 points

Case #4: You are seated across from the banker and mahjong on the hand shown below. Prevailing wind is West. How many points do you have based on these tiles?



- Short Straight—1 point
- Seat Position Flower (x2)—2 points
- White Dragon—1 point
- Hybrid—3 points

How many points do you have based on these tiles?
