Red Dragon—1 point

Seat Position Flower—1 point

All Five Suits—3 points

Case #2: You are seated to the right of the banker and mahjong on the hand shown below. How many points do you have based on these tiles?



Pure Dragon—3 points

All Chees—1 point

Two Suits—1 point

Case #3: You are seated across from the banker and mahjong on the hand shown below.
How many points do you have based on these tiles?



Big Three Dragons—9 points

Hybrid—3 points

Seat Position Flower—1 point

Case #4: You are seated across from the banker and mahjong on the hand shown below.
How many points do you have based on these tiles?



Twins—1 point

All chees—1 point

Seat Position Flower—1 point

Middle Tile (Middle Wait)—1 point
