PATTERNS:

Scrubbies (various)

The scrubbies use this yarn: [Creative Bubble](#)

Barbara's pattern for her scrubbies: Use a size 6 needle, cast on 30 stitches (Elizabeth uses 25), Barbara uses 30. Knit all rows until you have knit a square, then bind off.
