

Flower Wall

- The flower wall should be maintained so it contains **14 or 15 tiles**.
- If more tiles are needed, add **one STACK at a time** to the *back* of the flower wall, taking them from the **left end of the adjacent wall**.
- The **front** of the flower wall should be **3–4 tiles high** so players can easily distinguish it from the live wall.
- Flower wall tiles are used to replace melded **flowers** and melded **kongs**.
- Replacement tiles are **always taken from the front** of the flower wall.
- If the game ends with only the 14 flower-wall tiles remaining and no one has mahjonged, it is a **wall game**. In this case, there is no winner, tiles are washed, a new game is started, and the banker stays the same.
