

Winds, Flowers, Points

Tying it all together

Winds



Windicator



Flowers



Prevailing Wind	1	Pung or kong of the prevailing wind
Seat Position Wind	1	Pung or kong of the wind of your seat position
No Flower	1	Winning hand has no flower
Your Flower	1	Winning hand has a flower corresponding to your seat number

IMPORTANT NOTE: Only the winning hand gets to count points!

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Prevailing Wind

The wind that matches
windicator.

It does not matter who the
banker is—applies to all
players.

The prevailing wind is
“East” for all players.



= 1 point if you mahjong

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When the first
banker becomes
banker again, the
prevailing wind
advances one
direction.

E→S→W→N

The
prevailing
wind is
“South” for
all players.



= 1 point if you mahjong

Prevailing Wind Summary

- Prevailing wind is the wind that matches the windicator.
- Prevailing wind advances one direction each time the first banker becomes the banker again ($E \rightarrow S \rightarrow W \rightarrow N$).
- The prevailing wind applies to all player.
- Pung/Kong of the prevailing wind = 1 point (if you mahjong).

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Seat position winds: East, South, West, and North.

Seat numbers for flowers: 1, 2, 3, and 4.

Both are **ALWAYS** relative to the banker.

The banker's seat position wind is **ALWAYS** East and their flower seat number is **ALWAYS** 1.

For seat position wind, find the banker and rotate counter-clockwise:

Eat – East – (Banker)

Soup – South

With – West

Noodles – North

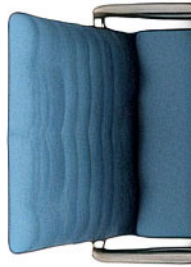
For the flower seat number, simply count counter-clockwise (1-2-3-4) starting with the banker as 1.

Flower - 4



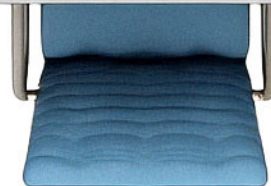

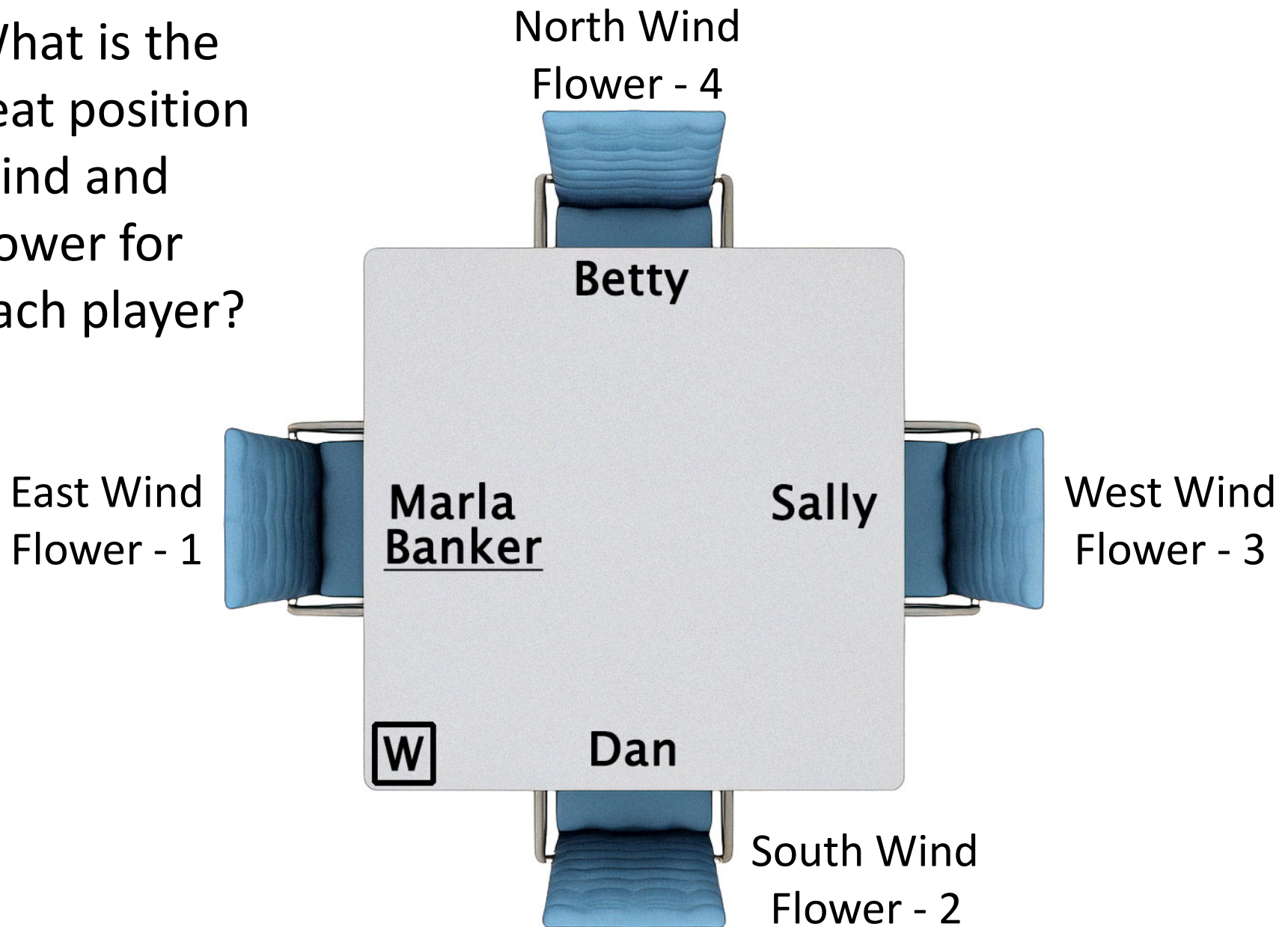

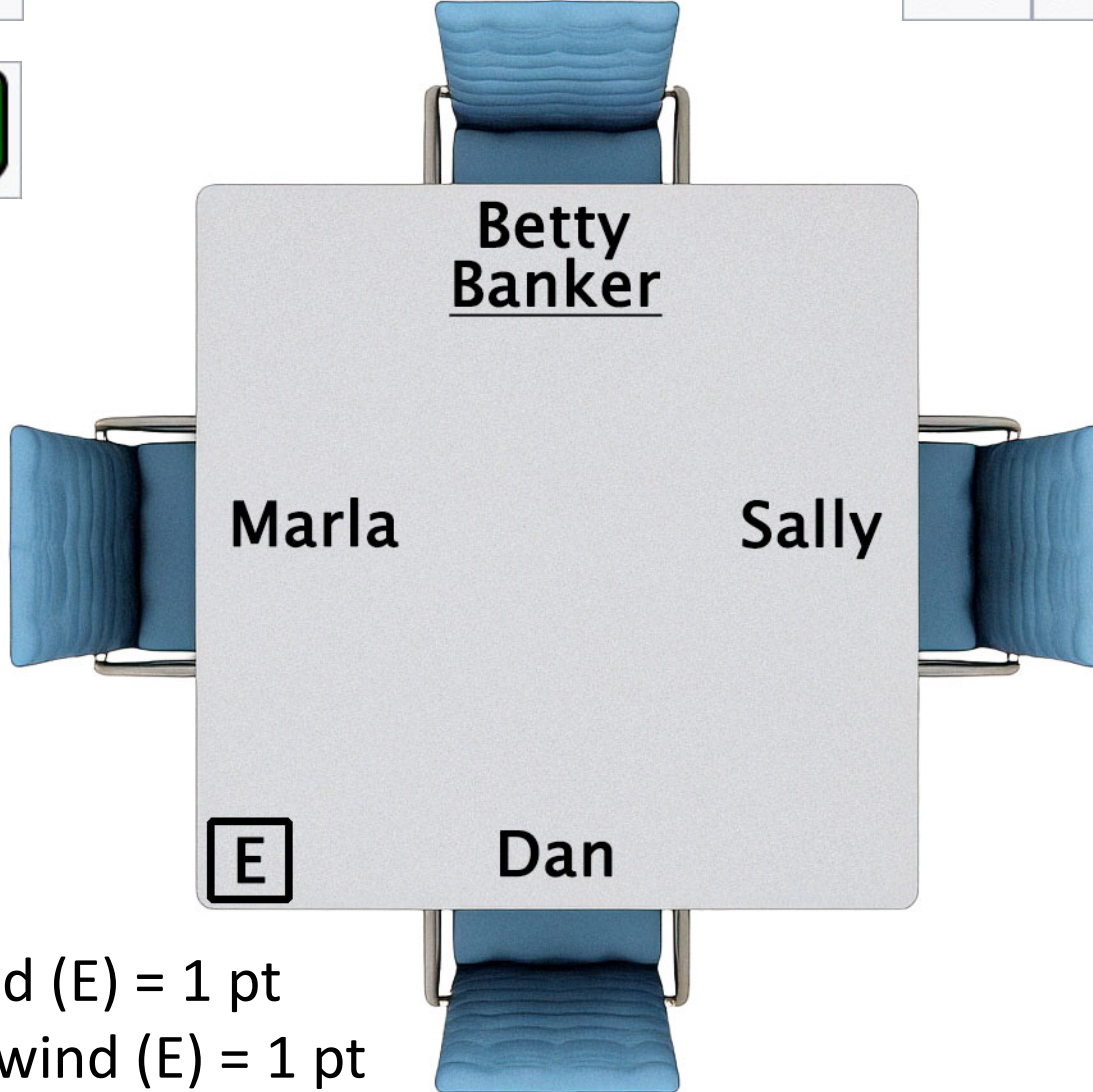

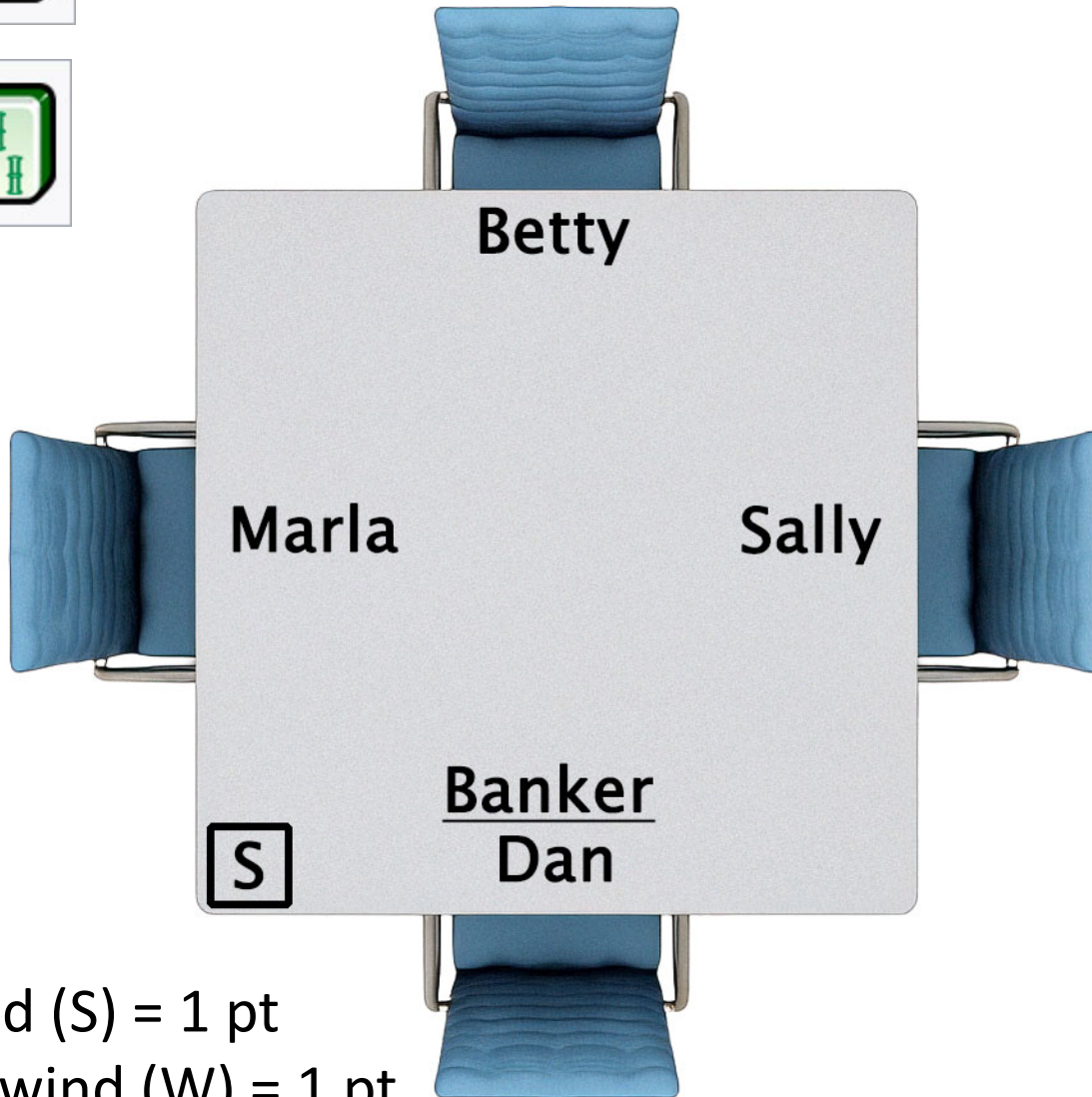


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How many
points does
Betty have?

Prevailing wind (E) = 1 pt
 Seat position wind (E) = 1 pt
 Seat position flower (1) = 1 pt



How many
points does
Betty have?

Prevailing wind (S) = 1 pt
Seat-position wind (W) = 1 pt
No flower = 1 pt



How many
points does
Betty have?

Prevailing wind (W) = 1 pt

REMINDERS

1. Only the winner gets to count points.
2. No points for having eyes of your seat-position wind or prevailing wind.
3. If only 3 players, nothing changes.
4. Beware of holding onto a single wind tile too long. Don't let it compromise getting a mahjong if other tiles have more potential.

CHICKEN HAND

½ point for a mahjong that
contains no other points
