

More ways to get 1 point
(if you mahjong)

All Chees	1	All chees and eyes in varying suits
Dragon	1	Pung or kong of any dragon (red, white, green)
Prevailing Wind	1	Pung or kong of the prevailing wind
Seat Position Wind	1	Pung or kong of the wind of your seat position
No Flower	1	Winning hand has no flower
Your Flower	1	Winning hand has a flower corresponding to your seat number
Self-Drawn Tile	1	Self-drawing the final tile to complete a mahjong
Robbing the Kong	1	Mahjong by taking a tile from a player making an exposed kong
Single Wait for Eye	1	Holding a single tile waiting for its mate to form eyes
Middle Tile (Closed Wait)	1	Waiting for the missing inside tile to form a chee
End Tile (Edge Wait)	1	Waiting for a missing 3 or 7 tile of a terminal chee

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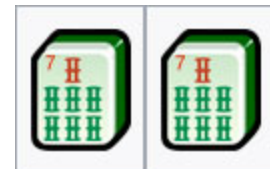
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Self-Drawn Tile	1	Self-drawing the final tile to complete a mahjong*
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*Not from the discards, but from the live wall or the flower wall.

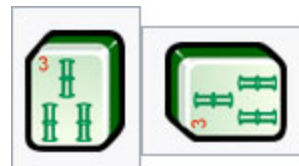
Robbing the Kong	1	Mahjong by taking a tile from a player <u>making</u> an exposed kong*
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Happens when a player with a melded pung promotes it to a kong.



*Mahjong must be called before the next player takes their tile.

Single Wait for Eye	1	Holding a single tile waiting for its mate to form eyes
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Single Wait for Eye	1	Holding a <u>single</u> tile waiting for its mate to form eyes
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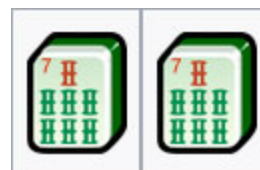
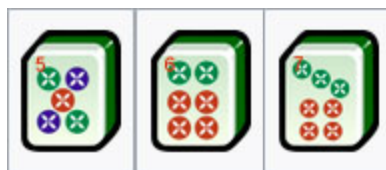


No point because player could have won on the 3-character **OR** the 6-character.

Middle Tile (Closed Wait)	1	Waiting for the missing inside tile to form a chee
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End Tile (Edge Wait)	1	Waiting for a missing 3 or 7 tile of a terminal chee
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Single Wait for Eye
Middle Tile (Middle Wait)
End Tile (Edge Wait)

These points are the reason we turn the
winning tile sideways.

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When counting your points, turn a discarded tile upside down for each point you earn.

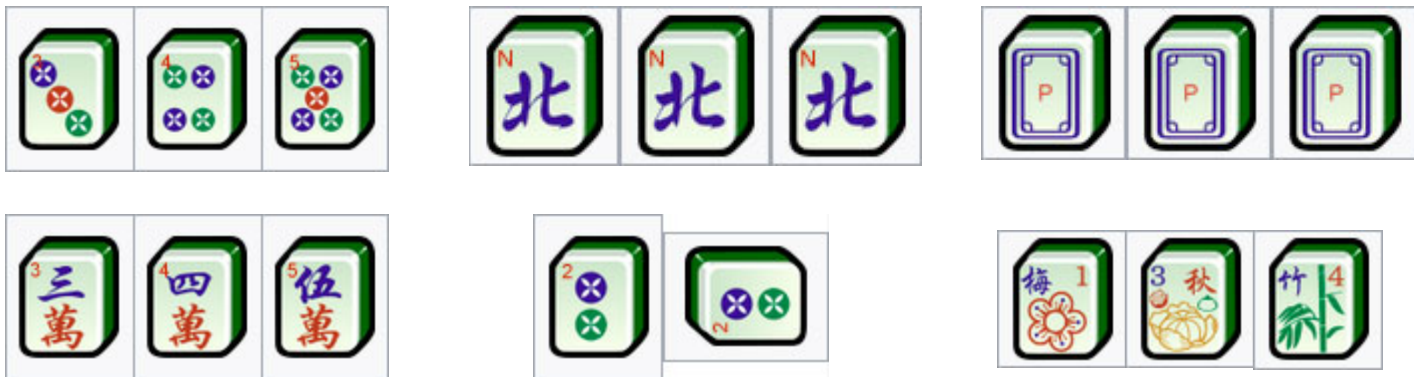
Banker mahjongs.
How many points do they have?



Middle tile –1 point

Seat Position Flower—1 point

Player to the left of the banker mahjongs.
How many points do they have?



Seat position wind—1 point

Dragon pung—1 point

Seat Position Flower—1 point

If prevailing wind is North—1 point

Player across from the banker mahjongs.
How many points do they have?



All chees—1 point
End tile—1 point
No Flower—1 point

Chicken hands are still OK.

Try to play with different people.
