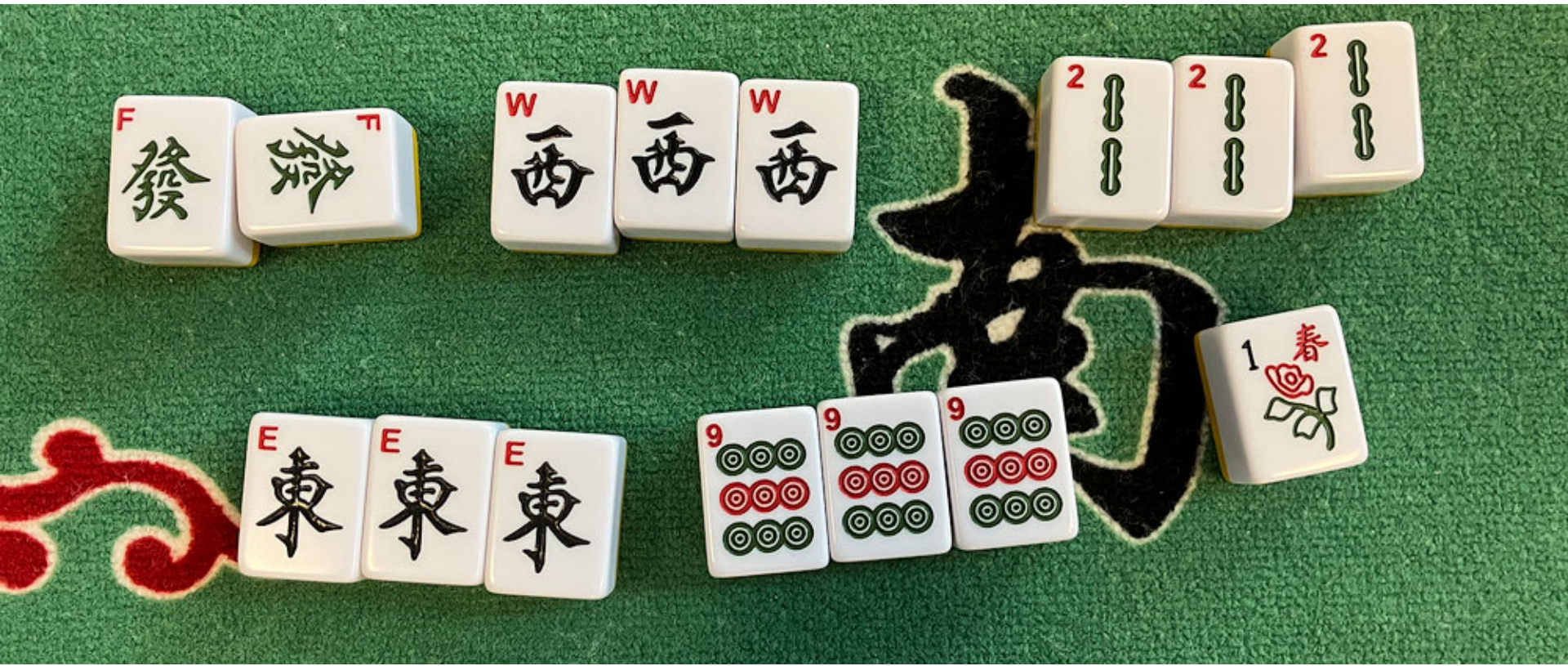


Case #1: You are the player across from the banker. The prevailing wind is South.

Case #2: You are the banker. Prevailing wind is East. You mahjong on the hand below. How many points do you have based on these tiles?



Case #3: You are seated to the left of the banker. Prevailing wind is East.
You mahjong on the hand below. How many points do you have based on these tiles?



Case #4: You are sitting across from the banker and mahjong on the hand shown below. How many points do you have based on these tiles?



Case #5: You are seated across from the banker and mahjong on the hand shown below. Prevailing wind is South. How many points do you have based on these tiles?
(Hint: That West wind tile represents a concealed kong of the West wind.)
